The Oakfield Unit at Chorley & District Hospital provides care and support for people suffering from a range of mental health problems.

This space was designed to accommodate a variety of activities and further expand the facilities of the unit.

The scheme is an intentionally distinct contrast to the straight, magnolia coloured corridor and cellular rooms seen elsewhere within the hospital.

A colour changing LED lighting system was designed and incorporated as a method of stimulation and relaxation, depending on which programme setting is used.
